

LIQUOR LIABILITY- MONOLINE

BAR

After having several drinks at a bar, a patron walks into another bar and is served one drink. While driving home, the patron enters the opposing lane and collides head-on with another vehicle. The driver and passengers of the other vehicle sustain serious injuries and sue the establishment for contributing to the intoxication of the patron who caused the accident.

A minor enters a bar and was given a 21 and older bracelet without having his ID checked. After drinking six beers, he left and drive off in his car. He crossed into the opposing lane and struck a 51-year old woman head-on. She died within minutes. \$725,000 was paid to her estate and legals costs were \$70,000.

RESTAURANT

An individual attended a business meeting at a restaurant, consuming four alcoholic beverages. After the meeting, he and two associates moved to the bar area and continued to drink. He did not appear intoxicated, but after leaving at 11:00pm, he was in an auto accident. The driver of the other car had multiple fractures and sustained vocal chord paralysis. Legal costs totaled \$15,398 with a claim payment of \$250,000.

A patron is served alcohol at an establishment, and while walking home is struck and killed by an automobile. The estate of the deceased person sues, alleging the negligent service of alcohol directly contributed to the accident.

Two patrons are involved in a fight. One patron sustains injuries and sues the establishment, alleging the negligent service of alcohol caused the fight.

CATERING

A caterer serves alcohol at a party and one of the guests becomes intoxicated. After the party, the intoxicated guest is involved in an auto accident and injures a third party. The third party sues the caterer, alleging negligence in providing alcohol to an obviously intoxicated person.
